## 2019/2020 Fire Season Impacts for Clarence Valley Council

- 2 Lives lost (Coongbar)
- 6,154 km<sub>2</sub> burnt by bushfires (59% of total FER area of 10,428 km<sub>2</sub>)\*
- 848 properties damaged or destroyed\*
- 365 head of cattle reported lost\*
- 5 bridges lost, key roads closed leaving communities isolated\*\*
- 1535 impacted rural landholders (as at 31/12/2019)\*\*\*
- Compounded by flooding in late January





## Recovery

- Recovery Assistance Point in operation from late Dec 2019 to early March 2020
- Recovery and Resilience Planning team commenced July 20 to coordinate recovery and preparedness activities
- Community meetings held in Dundurrabin, Nymboida and Ewingar
- Northern region Communities of Practice
- Clarence Valley Recovery Support Services Network kick off meeting scheduled for September 30
